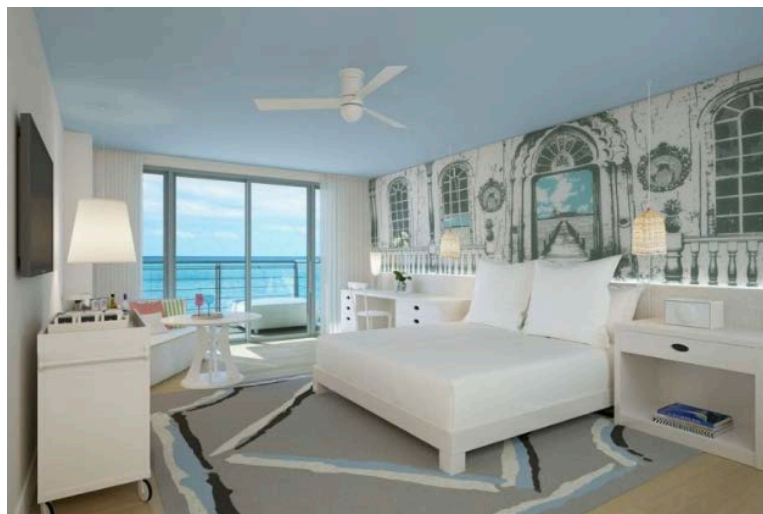
SLS LUX Dubuts in the Bahamas at Baha Mar
